### **Global Warming. What can we do about it?**

Global Warming is now known to be causing a great deal of destruction and desertification around the globe, and scientists know that this is only the very beginning. Expected effects include: rapidly spreading diseases, plant and animal range shifts and population changes, coral reef bleaching and die-off, heavy snowfalls, downpours and flooding, droughts and fires.
